financed by a \$10 million bond sale that trustees approved last year. The sale was part of a multi-year capital improvements plan in Orland Park that could reach \$30 million overall.

In addition to the pool improvements, the parks and recreation department is working on a major renovation around Lake Sedgewick, a special park for skateboarders and in-line skaters, and new ball fields in Centennial Park's northwest corner.

The skate park, which is costing about \$250,000 to build, should be open in June, Major said, but an elaborate grand opening is planned for the Fourth of July holiday.
